PROJECT TITLE

Closure of the CDR Slimes Dam at Middelburg Ferrochrome

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Samancor Middelburg Ferrochrome (MFC) facility, situated in Middelburg, Mpumalanga, was established in 1964 to produce Ferrochrome for use in the production of steel.

Until the year 2000, a process known as Chrome Direct Reduction (CDR) was undertaken, whereby chrome ore is brought into contact with finely divided coal at high temperature. During the CDR process a dust is produced as waste, which is captured with water sprays producing a slimes material of high moisture content. In the 1990's to the year 2000, MFC disposed of this CDR dust, known as CDR slimes, at a constructed disposal area located to the west of the MFC production facility. The CDR Slimes facility is licensed in terms of water use 21 (g) of the National Water Act, and the facility has been out of commission since the year 2000.

MFC wishes to apply for the formal decommissioning / closure of this facility in line with legislation. There are no intentions to use the facility in the future. The preferred alternative is that the CDR slimes material is removed to appropriate waste facilities, and the footprint area rehabilitated.

At an estimated in-situ density of 1.8 t/m³ this will entail removal of approximately 216 000 t of CDR waste.


